This committee is active in providing research, academic and technical support to the activities organized by different departments and college. Committee also reviews and supports faculties in developing research proposals for grant application for various activities such as seminars, workshops, research method courses or any other new activities planned. The committee has held various meetings to plan independent activities to be carried out by the college. The committee does not have any student's participation. Following are the activities planned and executed by the committee.

### Activities Planed and Conducted

1. Research Committee planed and approved the book project on the following themes for editing and publication. The books are being edited by different department's faculties under the chief editorship of Principal. Books will be published in coming months.
  - Interpreting Heritage: An Indian Experience
  - Nationalism in India: Its Emerging Contours
  - Epoch Making Legends of India: Mahatma Gandhi
  - Food Production
  - Sahitya aur Samkalim Sarovar
  - Psychology in Interdisciplinary Discourse: Scope and Challenges
2. The committee has approved to organize Faculty Development Program. Now five days Faculty development is scheduled to be organized from 22th September to 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2018. It was also decided by the committee that every year the college will organize at least one faculty development program having approximately 50 teachers and researchers from across the university and department.
3. The committee has approved to promote and organize 'Innovative Interdisciplinary Research projects' at least once in a year. Each project should involve teachers and 15 students to be involved in the field work.

With the consent and under the guidance of the Principal Research Committee has also discussed and decided that any of the academic activities of college such as lectures, seminars, workshops and conferences may be consulted and take advice and help of the research committee. In case of necessity Research Committee will be consulted for preparing proposal for research grants.
5. For participating in the events outside the college or organizing events within the college TICs of the respective departments should recommend the name of the teachers.
6. Field trips should be preferably be organized during the vacation period including Saturdays and Sundays. Lectures and Seminars should be organized preferably after 1:00 PM.
7. Finally, Research Committee is of the advisory nature so has been being consulted for research and academic related issues. A major event i.e. 'Faculty development program' is being organized by the members of research committee.
